As we are holding our Local History Project in the Hall this afternoon at 3.15pm, there will be no celebration assembly this week.

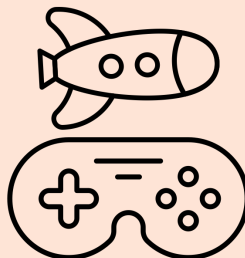


Online Safety
