Local History Exhibition

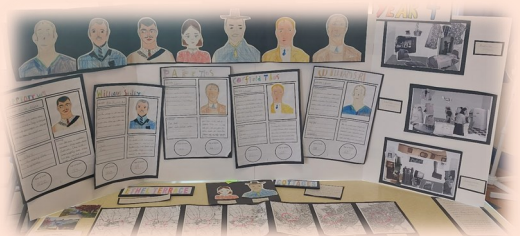
