

Brookdale Primary School Together we Believe, Progress, Succeed

Dear Parents and Families

I am writing to thank those of you who took the time to complete the Parent Survey earlier this month. Of 165 families in school, we had 85 responses and the feedback, as you will see, is overwhelmingly positive. We were pleased to also receive some useful feedback to consider with our senior leadership team, governing body and academy trust to further improve our children's experiences here at Brookdale.

Below, I have provided a full summary of the responses to our questions and an overview of recurring comments. Where necessary, myself or a member of the senior team will contact parents individually to discuss issues that have been raised that relate only to their child or issues that have not been raised by any other parent. **Please note that where parents have not provided names on the survey, we have been unable to follow some of these individual comments up.*

The main recurring suggestions for improvement were:

- 1. More opportunities for extra-curricular clubs
- 2. Opportunity for a holiday club provision at school
- 3. More opportunities to see how my child is progressing

Our response to these suggestions:

1. More opportunities for extra-curricular clubs

We are already offering Cross Country, Art, Chess, Gardening, Multi Skills, Gymnastics, Dance, Choir, Football and other sporting clubs for children in different year groups. Next year we will consider ways in which we could widen these opportunities to more children and will ask the children, through School Council, about any further clubs they would like us to consider offering. Some of these may be paid provision from outside of school staff and some may be offered by school staff themselves. Either at lunch time or after school.

2. Opportunity for a holiday club provision at school

We realise that this would be a great offer for our families however logistically, it does present some issues. The staff who run our very popular Acorns provision have term-time contracts and cannot be expected to also work during the school holidays. This means that the provision would need to be run by an external provider hiring the school premises. In situations where an external company lease part of the school building, the school remains responsible for pupils' safeguarding and we would also want to ensure the high-quality provision that our pupils receive from our own school staff which we would not be able to manage. We do try to share holiday club provision that is available in the local area before each school holiday, via the Brookdale Bulletin, to support families in finding suitable provision. I will discuss this matter further with the Governing Body at our Autumn meeting so that we can consider ways that we may be able to offer this type of provision in future.

3. More opportunities to see how my child is progressing

Parents are offered a Curriculum Morning and a parents' evening in the first term, a parents' evening in the second term and an end of year school report; the SENDCo also meets regularly with parents of SEND children. Class teachers and the headteacher are available at the start and end of every school day if parents wish to ask any questions about their child and are also happy to arrange longer appointments, via the school office, at any time to meet with parents if they wish to discuss anything in greater detail or are unable to see teachers at drop off or pick up times.

Next year we also plan to introduce termly open afternoons to allow families to come into the classroom at the end of each term to view their child's school work, celebrate their achievements and ask class staff any questions they may have; we trust that this will help families stay better informed about their child's progress.

Many thanks again for your continued support – our partnership with parents is of paramount importance to us and helps us to help the children feel happy and safe in school and to make the best possible progress while they are with us.






My child(ren) feels / feel safe at Brookdale.




The children at Brookdale are generally well-behaved and well-mannered.






The school makes me aware of what my child will learn during the year (e.g through Curriculum Mornings, reports, Parents' Evening and SEND meetings)




I feel that if I raise concerns with the school, they will be dealt with properly. 85 responses



Does your child have special educational needs and/or disabilities (SEND)? 85 responses






The school has high expectations for my child(ren).




The school lets me know how my child(ren) is/are doing. (e.g through Curriculum Mornings, reports, Parents' Evening and SEND meetings)




My child(ren) can take part in clubs and activities at this school.




The school supports my child(ren)'s wider personal development (e.g their mental health, personal safety and promoting their successes outside of school)




My child(ren)'s class teacher(s) are approachable and I have opportunities to raise concerns with them should I need to




