Uniform

Please note the following:

- → Children should wear plain black school shoes and not trainers. If children need to wear trainers for medical reasons, please inform Mrs Ball and also ensure these are black.
- → Socks should be black, white or grey
- → Long hair should be tied back every day
- → Hair accessories should be blue, yellow, white or black
- → No jewellery is allowed other than small stud earrings
- → No smart watches are allowed in school due to safeguarding reasons
- → Nail varnish and make-up should not be worn for school
