According to the 2024 Ofcom report into media attitudes among children and their parents, a third (32%) of 8-12 year olds reported seeing something worrying or nasty online in the past 12 months. What's more, almost two-fifths say they have adopted 'riskier' online behaviours. This is when children hide their internet activity so no one can check what they're viewing.
