#### Remembrance



#### Diwali

On Monday, Rahila from Wirral's MEAS (Minority Ethnic Achievement Service) came to deliver a workshop to Year 3 about the festival of Diwali which, this year, was celebrated by Hindus, Sikhs and Jains across the world on 1st November—Year 3 enjoyed the chance to make their own Rangoli patterns using coloured rice. Following this, she also delivered a whole-school assembly on the same theme. Rahila taught us <u>the story of Rama and Sita</u>, about some of the customs traditionally practised during this festival and even taught us some Hindi words!

On Thursday, they had a visit from Professor Jim from Liverpool University. He wowed the class with all the different sorts of rocks we have on Earth and taught them words like minerals, igneous, sedimentary and metamorphic.
